- 6 So that those who are dear to you may be delivered, *
save with your right hand and answer me.

“I will exult and parcel out Shechem; I will divide the valley of Succoth. *refrain*
- 8 Gilead is mine and Manasseh is mine; *
Ephraim is my helmet and Judah my scepter.
- 9 Moab is my washbasin, on Edom I throw down my sandal to claim it, *
and over Philistia will I shout in triumph.” *refrain*
- 10 Who will lead me into the strong city? *
who will bring me into Edom?
- 11 Have you not cast us off, O God? *
you no longer go out, O God, with our armies. *refrain*
- 12 Grant us your help against the enemy, *
for vain is the help of man.
- 13 With God we will do valiant deeds, *
and he shall tread our enemies under foot. *refrain*
